Lesson-07: Weighed and Wanting

Lesson Focus Passage: Daniel 5

Background: God's longsuffering and patience are cardinal attributes which reflect His grace and mercy toward sinners. But there is a line beyond which God's patience runs out – and the king of Babylon crossed that line. To test God's patience is to invite His sure judgment.

The wicked and blasphemous King Belshazzar was about to be judged on God's scale of His righteousness. The verdict for this awful king would prove to be fatal.
