Lesson-09 Study Guide: Daniel's Great Vision

Lesson Focus Passage: Daniel 7

Background: Professor **Alfred Weber**, a great historian, wrote a few years ago in *Farewell to European History*, "To the one endowed with historical perspective, it must be clear that we are in the end of world history as we know it."

What will be the final outcome of the nations in this period of history? Yes, we can know. We cannot know all the details, but God has provided for us a broad scope of prophecy.

The seventh chapter of Daniel provides the most comprehensive and detailed prophecy of future events that you will find anywhere in the Old Testament (**Dr. John Walvoord**, former President of Dallas Theological Seminary).

Preparatory Questions

Read: Psalm 2:1-12; Revelation 19:11-21

- 1. In Psalm 2, compare the "King" of verse 6 with the "Son of Man" in Daniel 7:13-14. Are they the same person?
 - a. What does God plan to give to His King?
 - b. What will the King do with rebellious kingdoms when He begins His rule?
- 2. In Revelation 19:11-21 we get a detailed description of what Daniel saw as only a glimpse in Daniel 7:13-14.
 - a. What title do you find in Revelation 19, which was also found in Psalm 2?
 - b. Compare the "little horn" of Daniel 7:8, 11 with the beast of verse 19. What do you conclude about their identity?
 - c. How do you reconcile Daniel 7:12 with Revelation 19:21?
- 3. If you were the ruler of a nation in this world, what you do in light of Psalm 2, Daniel 7, and Revelation 19?
